



Welshot Membership Terms and Conditions

1. For the purpose of brevity and clarity,
 - a. Welshot Imaging Ltd shall be known as Welshot
 - b. Any Academy Evening, Workshop, Experience Day or any variation of these terms shall be known as an event
 - c. Any person or body corporate that contracts Welshot to deliver any service(s) shall be known as a customer
 - d. A data subject is a person or body requesting disclosure of personal and confidential information stored by Welshot.
2. As per the Consumer Contracts Regulations 2014, you have the right to cancel your online or telephone booking up to 14 calendar days after making payment. In such instances, contact lee@welshotimaging.co.uk or telephone 01248 719126.
3. Any cancellation shall be liable to an administration charge that shall be set from time to time by Welshot.
4. All advertisement statements made by Welshot for any event (known as an invitation to treat) is not binding as soon as it is accepted by the person to whom the statement is addressed.
5. Delegate numbers are proportionate to the amount of Team Leaders and, if applicable, Models. This ratio shall be set from time to time and at the discretion of Welshot.
6. Subject to booking, food and refreshments will be made available during the course of the event. In the event that food and refreshments are unavailable, you will be advised during the booking process. Should the host venue be unable to supply food and/or refreshments during the event, Welshot cannot be held responsible. It is your responsibility to inform Welshot at the time of booking if you have any dietary requirements that may affect your health and wellbeing. Relevant catering suppliers will be notified of your dietary requirements but Welshot cannot accept any responsibility of errors and/or omissions made by third parties.
7. Once a booking is made and payment has been secured by Welshot, no refunds shall be made; however, this does not affect your statutory rights. In addition, in the event of your non-attendance at a booked event, Welshot is unable to refund, either wholly or in part, any monies paid.



8. On any given Welshot event, a proportion of the delegate spaces will be made available to holders of vouchers. Once these spaces have been filled, Welshot reserves the right to refuse admittance to any further voucher holders.
9. In the event of a duplicate booking being made, Welshot will not be liable for your error and monies will not be transferred or refunded. This does not affect your statutory rights under the Consumer Contracts Regulations 2014.
10. Any voucher issued by Welshot has no cash value.
11. Academy Evenings and Full Day Photographic Events may be transferred at the discretion of Welshot. You must inform Welshot via email (lee@welshotimaging.co.uk) no later than 14 calendar days prior to the booked event, and a transferral can only be done for a like-for-like booking which must be within three calendar months of initial event. This term can only be realised for the initial booking and not for subsequent rescheduled workshops/ events.
12. All events and workshops carry a limited amount of delegate spaces available for the redemption of members' free event/workshop vouchers. Please check the website (www.welshotimaging.co.uk) for availability.
13. In consideration of the customer's agreement to pay the cost of any event, Welshot shall supply the service(s) to the customer for the term subject to and in accordance with the terms and conditions of the agreement.
14. Unless otherwise stated, membership of Welshot shall be for 12 calendar months, beginning on the first day when full, cleared payment has been received by Welshot for said membership.
15. Welshot is in no way obliged to accept any person or body corporate as members and reserves the right to refuse or cancel memberships at its absolute discretion.
16. Members must adhere to Welshot's Code of Ethics at all times when attending events and when communicating with the company, its staff and agents. Failure to adhere to this may result in withdrawal of membership and exclusion from any further participation in organised activity arranged and/or provided by Welshot.

17. The entire copyright of photographs taken by a member on any Welshot event is retained by the photographer at all times throughout the world.
18. Welshot (including its employees and agents) will treat all confidential information it receives as confidential, safeguard it accordingly and not disclose to any other person without the prior written permission of the disclosing party, nor will it use or exploit the disclosing party's confidential information in any way except for the purposes anticipated under the agreement.
19. In accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation, Welshot (as a data controller) is legally obliged to provide, upon request, an overview of the categories of data being processed as well as a copy of the actual data relating to the data subject making the request. Furthermore, Welshot has to inform the data subject on details about the processing, such as the purpose of the processing, with whom the data is shared and how it acquired the data.
20. These terms and conditions shall not be varied except by agreement in writing.
21. This agreement shall be governed by the laws of England and Wales.
